


Representation of Groundwater Reservoirs

Mission: To monitor and report on groundwater levels to understand the resource so it is a reliable, safe and adequate supply for our residents.


Activities: Monitor groundwater levels

- We have measured the potential interaction between Delaware River and wells along the river




Highlight: Early Warning System


- The impact of the current drought is being closely monitored.
