2. Carozza logger replaced 7/18/2025, and the unit is from 2011; **Ping 86.2, sample 4.74 -what's up?**
3. Ballantine logger needs to be replaced, it has been recording the same value since 7/21/2025; the unit is from 2011 and is a 150' logger. Replacement options:
 - a. A 275' logger that dates to 2015

 - c. and a 300' from 2019.
