Continuous Monitoring Network (CMN)

1. Skow well logger removal; Tom will give well logistics to Todd Quimby for a proposal
2. Gruver East logger replacement; Mary will speak to the owner about available electric to install new logger
3. Mary completed CMN downloads 6/30/2025; late seasonal high and lower than previous years
4. Decision to remove the Eno logger from Carrie's well and replace it with a Global Water logger, which is better suited for a shallow well.

Static Water Level Network (SWL)

1. S. Donovan completed Nockamixon pings and two CMN loggers (Lodi Hill and Rt. 412)
 - a. Rt. 412 logger (adjacent to PHS) has a Fall/Spring delta of 1.5 ft, indicating low stress on the aquifer


