Parks and Rec reported that they did not have a report because committee did not have a quorum or chairman.

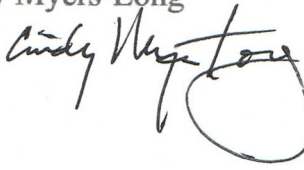
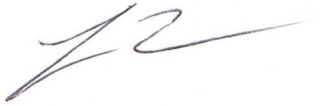
New Business
