In attendance: Eleanor Breslin, Michael Kauffman, Judith Danko, and Scott Holbert, Township Solicitor, were present at the meeting. John Cole was absent and Curt Genner, Township Engineer was not needed at this meeting.

Chairperson Breslin called the public meeting of the Tinicum Township Board of Supervisors to order at 12:00 PM, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting, held in the Tinicum Township building meeting room, was live-streamed on Zoom and recorded. There were approximately 1 people present, and 0 people viewed it online.

A. Announcements

Executive Session on 9/4 was held at 12:00 pm for a property matter.

B. Action Items

1. Consideration by the Board of Supervisors to contract Special Labor Counsel services with Christopher Gerber Esquire, Lamb/McErlane PC.

Motion to contract Special Labor Counsel services with Christopher Gerber Esquire, Lamb/McErlane PC was made by Michael Kauffman and seconded by Eleanor Breslin. (All in favor, 2).

2. Consideration by the Board of Supervisors to purchase a Sper Sound Recorder/Datalogger and Accoustical Calibrator with traceable certificate of calibrations for the Police Department not to exceed cost of \$1,300.00.

Motion to purchase a Sper Sound Recorder/Datalogger and Accoustical Calibrator with traceable certificate of calibrations for the Police Department not to exceed cost of \$1,300.00 was made by Eleanor Breslin and seconded by Michael Kauffman. (All in favor, 2).

Judith Danko stated that Chief Nicole will ask the Police Foundation to fund this item. Eleanor asked Judith to explain why this equipment is needed. Ms. Danko stated that the equipment is needed and must be calibrated meter and sensitive enough to make accurate readings to register noise levels. And with regards to our Police Department being trained properly to utilize the equipment and in conjunction and in accordance with our Township Ordinances so that violations are appropriately recorded and enforced.

Ms. Breslin stated that it doesn't make sense to have a noise ordinance in our township if we do not have the equipment that is needed in order to enforce and to most appropriately and effectively addressed concerns raised by our residence and are brought to our attention.

3. Consideration by the Board of Supervisors to authorize Community Noise Enforcement training for our four police officers not to exceed cost of \$3,100.00.

Ms. Breslin stated that the Police Foundation will be considering covering the cost of this expense as well. In the event that the Police Foundation cannot cover the expense she will make a motion momentarily for the Township to pay for this expense.

Motion to approve our Planning Commission's and Engineer's recommendations of the Rural Road Classification Map was made by Eleanor Breslin and seconded by Michael Kauffman. (All in favor, 2).

C. Public Comment – None was made.

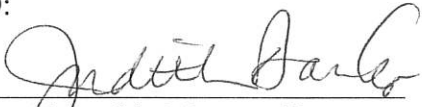
D. Adjournment
