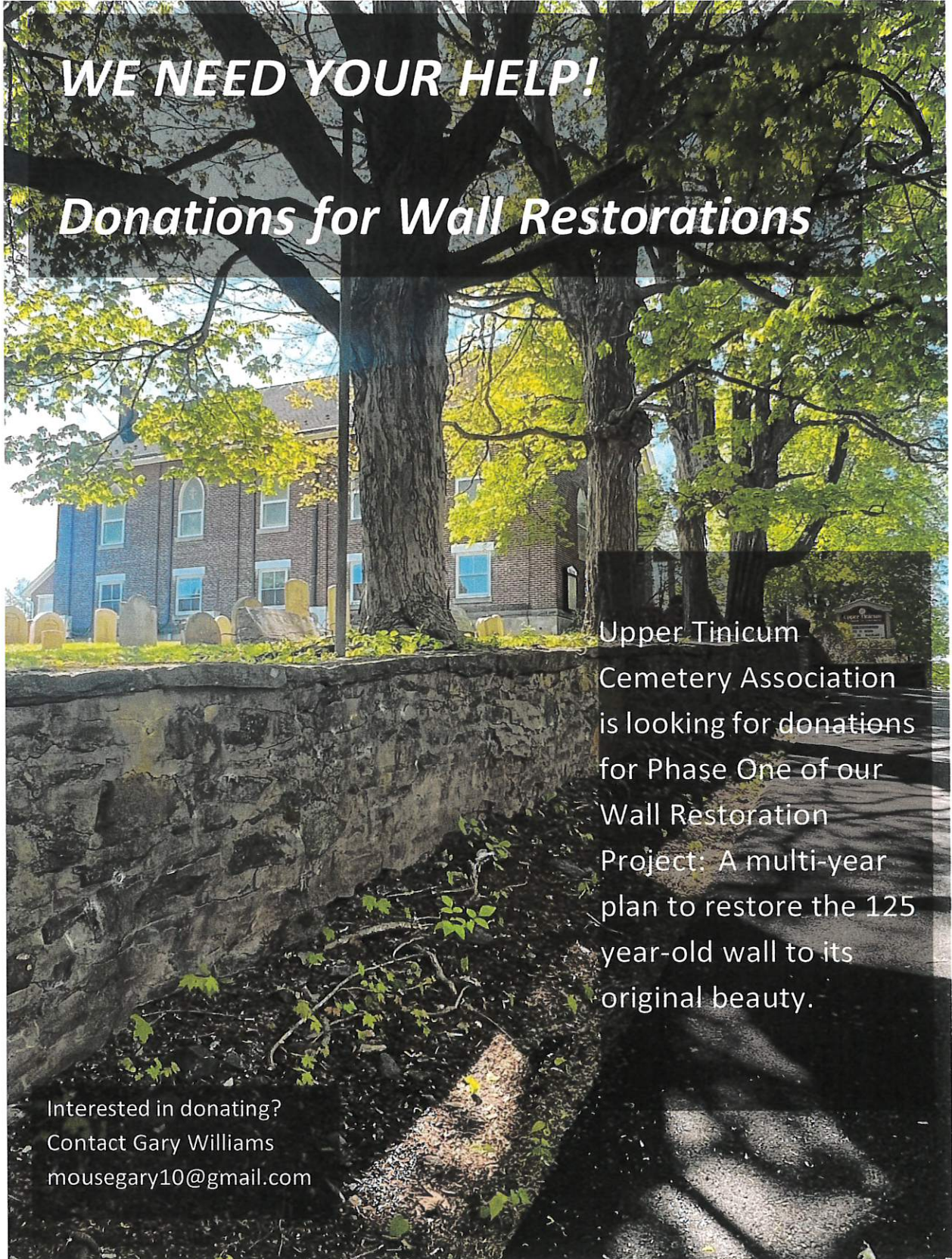
Project Summary

Project Name

Upper Tinicum Lutheran Church and Cemetery

Project Description

The Upper Tinicum Lutheran Church and Cemetery is located atop the Delaware River Palisades within Tinicum township's historic, cultural & scenic corridors in upper Bucks County, PA. adjacent to Uhlerstown Village and Rural Historic District. The church, cemetery, and stone wall are on 8 acres and under non-profit ownership, surrounded by preserved farmland and open space. The 2-story brick church was constructed in 1893, after fire destroyed the original 1852 church, both concurrent with the peak of canal-era activities. The Upper Tinicum Cemetery Association. assumed non-profit ownership of the cemetery in 1920. The cemetery contains graves of generations of local families and 324 veterans dating from the 1812 War to present. The site is an excellent intact example of rural ecclesiastica¹ architecture considered vernacular S.E. PA, reflective of the influence and style of German immigrants who settled there in mid-19th century.
